

Walk from Holmbeck Farm to Ascott House



1. From the clubhouse, cross the runway just before the windsock. Keeping a hedge on your right, descend and go through the gap in the hedge at the bottom of the airfield.



5. Ignoring the track immediately right, go straight ahead to follow Burcott High Street and then turn right onto the main Soulbury Road. After a few yards, take the first footpath on the left.



2. Through the hedge, turn left, and follow the hedge on your left, pass through a gate. Towards the end of the field, look out for a path through the hedge over a wooden footbridge.



6. Keeping next to the hedge on your right, turn right at the top of the hill, and descend to a gate, and follow the path into Long Spinney and across a footbridge.



3. Cross the footbridge, and keep straight ahead across the next field to a kissing gate in the opposite hedge.



7. Take a well-made path climbing slightly left which runs along the back of houses on your right. Continue as the path joins Meadow Way and turn left at the end to follow Moorlands Road to the A418.



4. Follow the path upwards through an orchard-like area, generally keeping left until you reach a gate onto a road.



8. Turn left, and it's about ¼ mile along the A418 to Ascott House Visitor's entrance. (Enter through the closer cricket entrance if it's open!) The entrance booth is in the car park.
